Coronavirus Statement

Dear MorningStar Family,

Although a case of COVID-19 has been confirmed in Wichita this morning, MorningStar WILL CONTINUE to have all planned activities unless public officials change their current restrictions (no gatherings of more than 250 people). We will keep you informed if any future cancellations become necessary.

Should we become unable to gather, we will pursue online platforms (i.e., Facebook live) to continue providing spiritual nourishment from God's Word. We haven't utilized these in the past, but we are committed as elders to providing you with vital spiritual resources, which sustain us every day but especially in times like we are facing today.

We will continue to be diligent in keeping our building's surfaces clean and disinfected to help safeguard your health.

Based on CDC recommendations, we would like to make the following requests:

DO NOT COME to gatherings if you have a compromised immune system or have ANY SIGNS of cold/cough or any type of fever or fatigue. Though allergies are also peaking now, please even be cautious with scratchy throats and runny noses. Please also consider not coming if you have an immediate family member showing the above symptoms. Please stay home and take care of them!

IF COMING, PLEASE DO NOT SHAKE HANDS. This goes against our nature but it's an important precaution. A smile will have to do for now :^)

IF COMING, PLEASE USE HAND SANITIZER located on the small table at the back of the church. Also, please wash your hands regularly for at least 20 seconds each time.

PLEASE NOTE: we will not be passing the offering bags for the next few weeks but will have a collection box so that you can continue giving your tithes and offerings to the Lord.

PLEASE PRAY for one another. We strongly believe that God is in control of these things and protects us according to His will as we seek Him in prayer (and wash our hands!) Now is a crucial time to do all that we can to pray for our church, our community, and our country during this trying time.

THIS IS IMPORTANT. If you are hindered from obtaining food, medicine or other necessary items due to having a compromised immune system and/or are concerned about being around other shoppers, please let one of the elders know and we, or someone in the congregation, will make sure your needs are met. We are family and families take care of one another!
